**Engages** with local, regional and international organizations

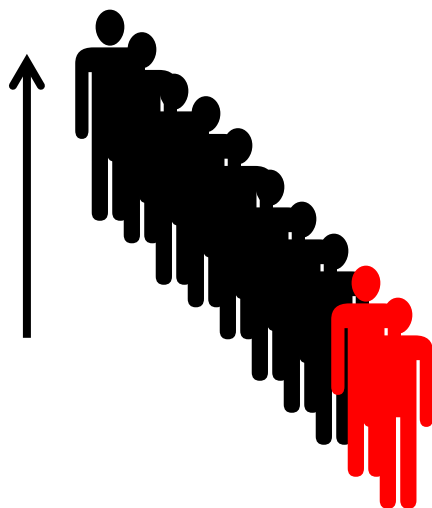

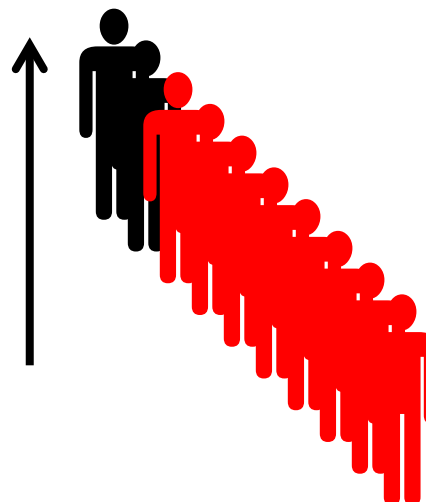

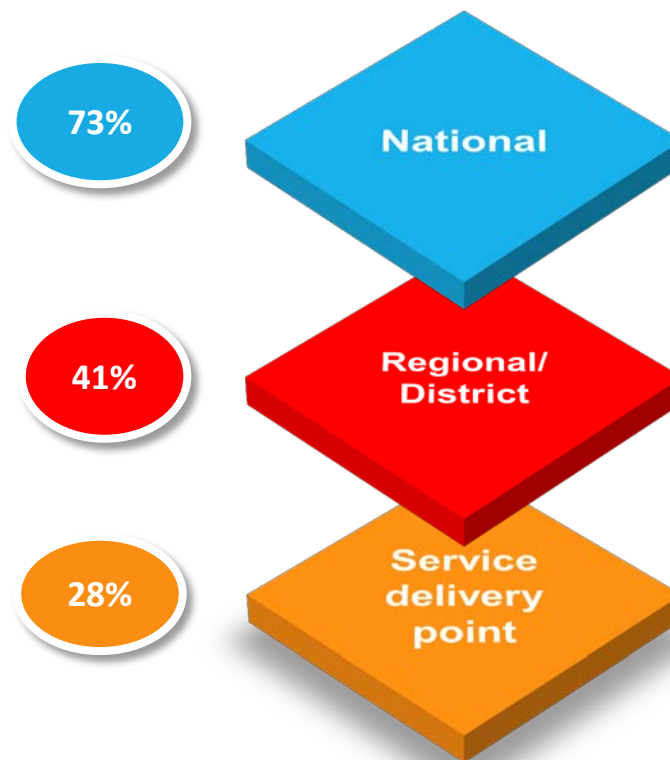

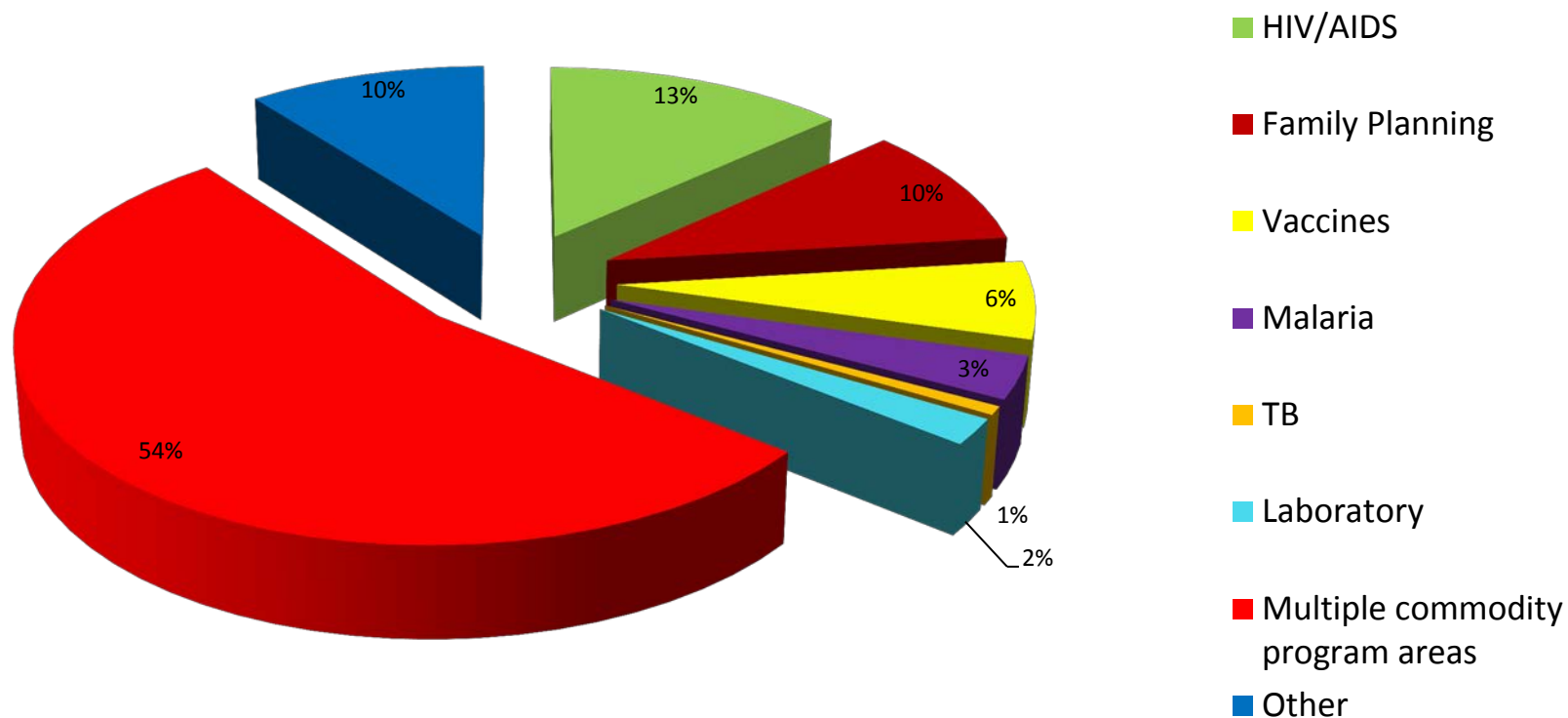
